Executive Summary:

Pursuant to the Agency's Procurement Ordinance No. 108, the General Manager has authority to approve purchases and public works change orders for up to \$100,000. In addition, the General Manager has the authority to waive the formal solicitation process when there are compelling reasons (public safety, prevent loss of life, imminent danger, emergency procurement or other valid reason), provided the information is documented to the Board of Directors at the next regularly-scheduled meeting.

To mitigate potential schedule delays, maintain compliance with regulatory and contractual obligations, including potential financial penalties and in support of the Regional Plant No. 5 (RP-5) Expansion Project's success, staff is recommending the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager, or his designee, the authority to approve necessary purchases and change orders specifically associated to the RP-5 Expansion project. All procurements and change orders executed under this requested authorization will be brought back to the Board for ratification at the next regularly-scheduled meeting, consistent with the existing requirement.

In support of keeping the Board informed on the project's progress, staff will provide monthly updates through the Engineering, Operations, and Water Resources Committee meeting.

Executive Summary:

The Treasurer's Report of Financial Affairs for the month ended November 30, 2019 is submitted in a format consistent with the State Requirement.

For the month of November 2019, total cash, investments, and restricted deposits of \$254,945,694 reflects an increase of \$4,621,771 compared to the total of \$250,323,923 reported for October 2019. The increase was primarily due to receipt of \$5.6 million of property taxes. As a result, the average days cash on hand for the month ended November 30, 2019 increased from 218 days to 228 days.

The unrestricted Agency investment portfolio yield in November 2019 was 2.375 percent, a decrease of 0.038 percent compared to the October 2019 yield of 2.375 percent. The slight decrease in overall yield is mainly attributed to the lower yields in the Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) and in the California Asset Management Program (CAMP) funds reflective of declining interest rates in the market.

Background

Subject: Treasurer's Report of Financial Affairs

The Treasurer's Report of Financial Affairs for the month ended November 30, 2019 is submitted in a format consistent with State requirements. The monthly report denotes investment transactions that have been executed in accordance with the criteria stated in the Agency's Investment Policy (Resolution No. 2019-3-1).

Agency total cash, investments, and restricted deposits for the month of November 2019 was \$254.9 million, an increase of \$4.6 million from the \$250.3 million reported for the month ended October 31, 2019. The increase was primarily due to receipt of \$5.6 million of property taxes.

Table 1 represents the unrestricted Agency investment portfolio, by authorized investment and duration, with total portfolio amount of \$135.0 million. The Agency portfolio excludes cash and restricted deposits in the amount of \$119.8 million held by member agencies and with fiscal agents.

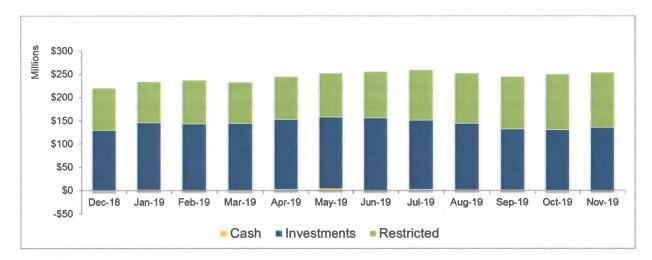


Figure 1: Cash, Investments, and Restricted Deposits

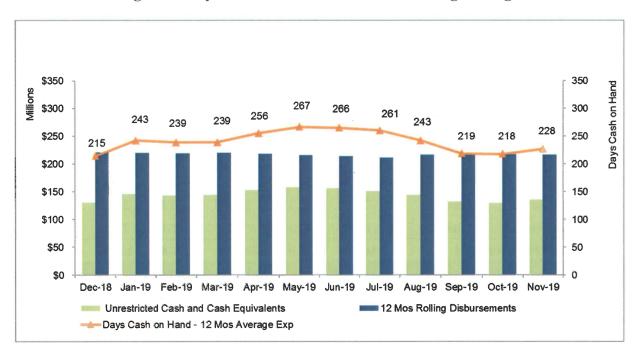
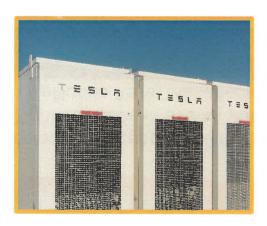


Figure 2: Days Cash on Hand – 12 Month Rolling Average

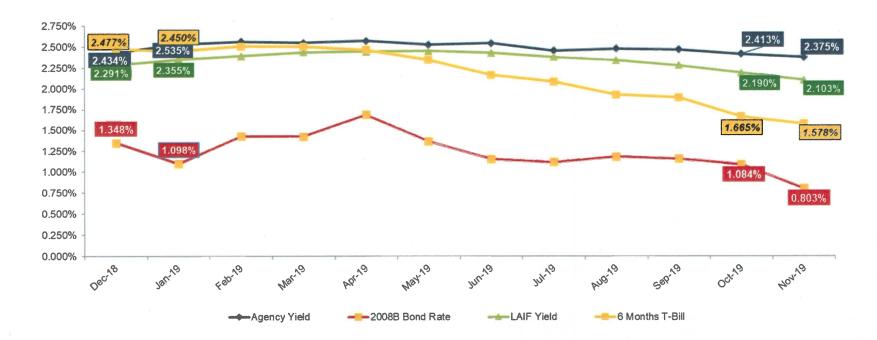

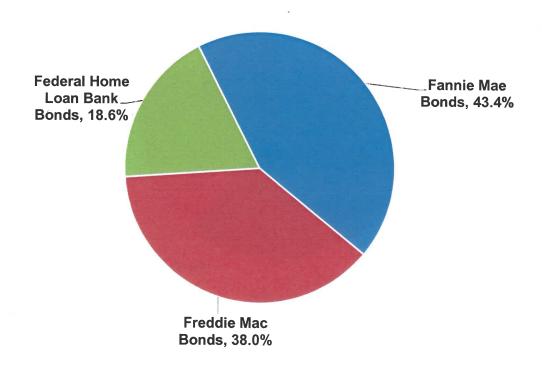

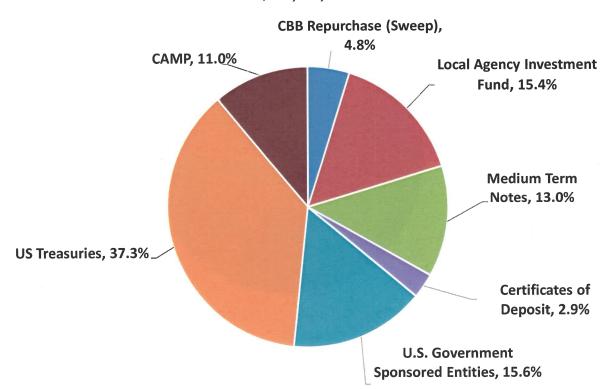

Month Ended November 30, 2019 Unrestricted Agency Investment Portfolio \$135,014,508

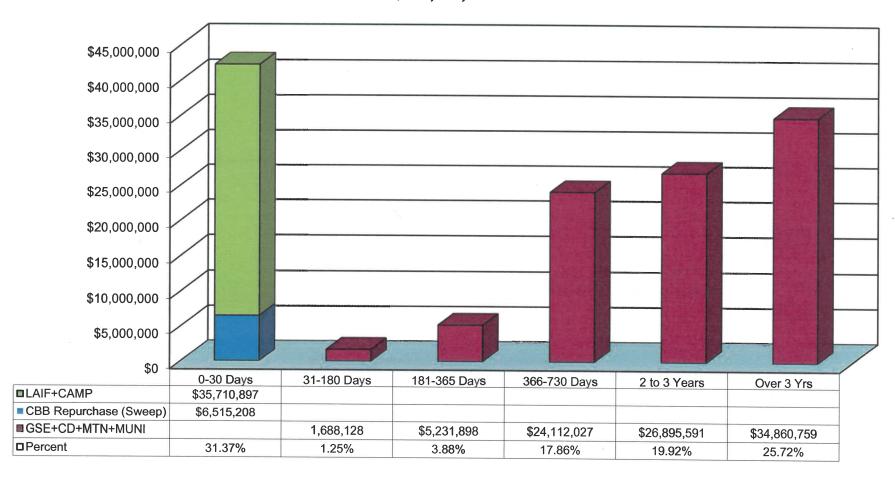
